Medium-wave facilities in Laos, Cambodia, and the Philippine were also examined, but none are available that could provide adequate coverage of North Viet Nam due to either insufficient power or the use of frequencies that would suffer serious interference from other co-channel stations.

The following information was obtained from the appropriate Pentagon office this morning regarding military medium-wave facilities which could be used for an expanded Vietnamese broadcast effort:

One 50 KW medium-wave transportable is now on training exercise at Fort Bragg, with operating unit. This could be withdrawn from the exercise and moved by air with unit. Estimated 7 to 10 days for the move and setting up.

One additional 50 KW medium-wave transportable is now at Fort Bragg, but is damaged and without an operating unit. No estimate is available as to the extent of damage, or the time it would take to repair. If a high enough priority were set, some sort of operating unit could be pulled together from the military.

A 50 KW medium-wave transportable is now engaged in an operation in connection with Cambodia. Unless its present mission were scrubbed, this would not be available for the Viet effort.

Airborne transmitters, based upon previous experience, would have coverage up to a distance of approximately 75 miles (assuming an altitude of 12,000 feet), from a point below the aircraft's location. This might provide some very limited coverage of North Viet Nam.
