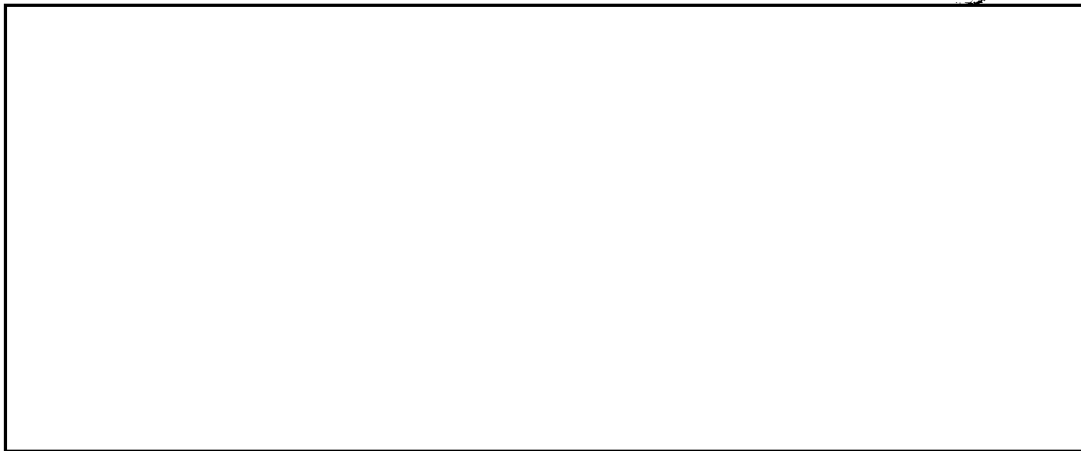

At a meeting on 12 January including DCI, Mr. Bundy, Secretary Rusk, Secretary McNamara, Mr. Johnson, and General Taylor, it was agreed to study the question of an abort procedure for U-2 missions over Cuba. A question was raised as to how many sorties would have aborted in the last 30 to 45 days if there had been in effect a procedure calling for an abort when a signal was received to the effect that (a) fruit-set radar had swept the U-2 or (b) that the radar was locked on.
