

The Director will not condone the use of the contract mechanism for the purpose of increasing personnel strength levels outside the framework of allocated ceiling strengths, either in the US or abroad. The President has specifically enjoined the Heads of all Departments and Agencies to avoid using this kind of authority to evade compliance with the employment levels which have been established for each government agency.
