1. We have received ACSI memorandum of 2 December 1963 concerning information on [Redacted] As regards the original development of information concerning [Redacted] this Agency in March 1960 furnished to the National Security Agency information which had been received from an applicant for employment and from various sources [Redacted] This information was passed to the NSA representative with the request and understanding that the NSA would also furnish this information to the Army Security Agency. It will be noted from the enclosures to your memorandum of 2 December 1963 that an NSA representative did pass information concerning [Redacted] to the Army Security Agency on 22 March 1960. It was felt that the passage of this information to the NSA and ASA served the security purpose and properly discharged our responsibilities.

2. In September when the ramifications of the [Redacted] became evident, available information in the Agency on [Redacted] was forwarded to the FBI on 6 September 1963, to the NSA on 16 September 1963 and to the DIA on 21 October 1963. It is regretted that dissemination of this information was not also made to you at an earlier date than 28 September 1963. In reference to the report of information on [Redacted] given to a representative of your Office on that date, the report was not marked by this Agency "For Lead Purposes Only". Your representative was cautioned on certain aspects

of the information but [redacted] that your use of the information be restricted as was indicated by your letter. You are certainly free to disseminate this information as you deem appropriate and necessary.

3. You can be assured that any information of a counter-intelligence and security interest affecting the responsibilities of the Department of the Army will be made available as promptly and expeditiously as possible. [redacted] has been located in [redacted] and arrangements for his interview are being made. This action is being coordinated with all interested agencies, including AC&SI. You will be kept currently advised of all developments.
