MEMORANDUM FOR THE HEADS OF EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES

Subject: Views of Federal employees on Government military and
civilian pay

As Chairman of the President's Special Panel on Federal Salaries, I ask for your assistance in carrying out the President's request that the Panel invite the views of civilian employees and uniformed personnel.

The Panel must report to the President on April 1. In order that it may have adequate time to consider the views of interested Federal personnel, the Panel asks that this memorandum be posted, both in Washington and in the field, on agency bulletin boards used for notifications to employees.
