MEMORANDUM FOR: Deputy Director for Support

Bob:

As you know, [redacted] is on the DD/S&T Table of Organization and handles their travel arrangements. This is in contrast to the remainder of the Agency which handles its travel arrangements through the Central Processing Branch of the Office of Personnel.

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As I recall, the initial [redacted] arrangement was made for security reasons many years ago [redacted]

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[redacted] The propriety of this arrangement was raised with me a couple of years ago when I was Deputy Director for Support and, as I remember, I took the position that I could not see very much net gain in transferring the [redacted] responsibility to DD/S. However, as Executive Director-Comptroller I am having some second thoughts about this. From my point of view, I would prefer to be able to look to one Deputy Director rather than two to find out about first-class travel and all other related matters.

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I should very much appreciate your re-examining this arrangement with the DD/S&T and making recommendations to me by 1 May. I realize that there are special security problems to be considered, but I feel that they are not insurmountable. For example, I see no reason why [redacted] could not operate from a displaced location if this is necessary.
