MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Personnel

Emmett:

Attached are copies of correspondence from [redacted] who wrote a "cold" letter to the Director of Personnel asking about the Career Training Program. He sent copies to me.

I got to know [redacted] during an extended TDY [redacted] where I dealt several times daily with the [redacted] - he handled all the chores which a colonel passes down the line until a young lieutenant actually does them. He worked hard for long hours and was always cheerful and cooperative.

[redacted] is a reserve officer soon to be released by the Army. When he expressed interest in CIA employment I encouraged him to write. He is sincere and, I think, genuinely dedicated to a career in intelligence. I don't think his attached letter does justice to his extensive residence and travel abroad, which has made him adaptable to the sort of conditions we meet in the Agency.

Perhaps it would be worthwhile to have this note catch up with the original of his letter of application.
