SUBJECT : Proposed Trip to Europe

1. This confirms the telephone conversations between [redacted] of my staff, and Mr. John McKenzie, of your staff, regarding your proposed trip to Europe.

2. Our people most knowledgeable of the areas concerned do not believe that there is any serious problem of physical security for you and Mrs. Strauss in Denmark, Holland, Belgium, France, Spain, Italy or England.

3. In France and Italy, where there is considerable Communist strength, [redacted]

4. This Agency frequently gives special briefings to members of the government when making trips abroad, and we would be delighted to provide you and your group with such a briefing.
