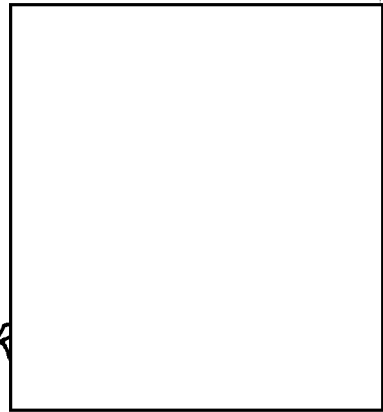

Dear Walt:

As a result of your 17 May 1960 letter to the Director, we made a search for material we might have which would relate to [redacted] the people named in your letter. Two reports appeared to have possible relevancy, and as they were classified I arranged to have them shown to Mr. Thomas K. Hall and Mr. William S. Kenney of your office to determine whether they could be declassified for your use. Apparently the information in these reports will not be useful for your purposes, and they were brought back to the Agency.

We shall continue to be on the lookout for information in connection with this case, and if any material turns up we shall call Messrs. Hall or Kenney. If your office has any further requests and there is any urgency, I suggest you call my office and we can have an appropriate search made and report to you. Whenever the classification of information appears to be a problem, we shall follow the same procedure and go over the material with your representatives to determine whether you wish to use it.
