Reference is made to your letter dated 19 July 1956 concerning the United States versus Otto VERBER and Kurt L. PONGER, in which a final appraisal is requested of the completeness, accuracy and truthfulness of the information supplied to this Agency by the defendants, as well as any other material which might bear upon the good faith of VERBER and PONGER in their interviews with representatives of U.S. intelligence.

This Agency must first note that it has proven impossible to check the major portion of the information supplied by VERBER

investigation indicates that they provided the full story of their contact with Seviet intelligence; rather it should be said that the description of their handling by Seviet intelligence presents no glaring discrepancies when compared with information in our possession.
