Our stated policy for all personnel actions is that they will be based only on individual qualifications and relative merit, and that no other considerations will apply. The actual application of this policy within the Agency has been successful to the extent that we have never had a complaint based on discrimination.

The size of the Agency and its administrative methods have made unnecessary any considerable elaboration or special internal training in connection with our merit policy. Should it be considered desirable at some time in the future to issue something similar to the letter on this subject published by the Secretary of the Interior, we will furnish you with a copy as requested.

I do appreciate your sending me the copy of the Department of the Interior policy statement. You may be sure that the President's Fair Employment Program has my full sympathy and support.
