: Report to the President on Implementation of Recommendations of the Joint Study Group

1. I refer to Recommendation No. 11 of the 2 July 1961 Report to the President by the President's Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board, and to the subsequent memorania from Mr. hundy requesting reports on the status of implementation of those Joint Study Group recommendations which fall within the respective responsibilities of the Departments of State and Defense and the Central Intelligence Agency.

- 2. As you are evers, the majority of the resonmendations of the Joint Study Group require either action by the intelligence community as a whole, or joint action by two or more assubers of the community. The Coordination Staff intends, therefore, to presere for signature by the Director of Central Intelligence (in his capacity as coordinator) a report to the President covering the status of implementation of those Joint Study Group recommendations which, on the attached statement entitled "Primary Responsibilities for Implementation of the Joint Study Group Recommendations" are prime facie the responsibility of the Director of Central Intelligence, the United States Intelligence Board, and jointly of DOD and CIA, State and CIA, and DCI and USIB
- 3. As a consequence of his coordination and other responsibilities under MSCID No. 1, the Director's report will also include, where appropriate, comments on other recommendations for which primary responsibility rests with the Department of State or the Department of
- 4. In preparing this report, we intend to follow generally the formet used in the report "Status of Actions on Recommendations of the Joint Study Group" dated I May 1961, of which you have received a copy.
- 5. We wish, of course, in preparing the Director's report, to take into account the views of the Department of Defense concerning any recommendation in which it has an interest. With this in mind,
