MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: Soviet statement with respect to their nuclear propelled "rocket" submarines

Attorney General's speech on the occasion of the launching of the John Marshall Polaris Submarine, stated "that the Soviet Union also has nuclear submarines armed with powerful rockets of various types -- submarines not inferior in speed to the American but faster. The Soviet Union has more and not less of them, in a word, the required number."

For several years now the Intelligence Community has estimated that the Soviets were engaged in a major program of constructing nuclear and ballietic missile submarines; the latter, we had estimated, being both conventional and nuclear powered.

On 18 July, in briefing the Stanais Preparedness
Subcommittee of the Armed Services Committee of the Senate, I
summarized the view of the Intelligence Community with regard to
the Soviet nuclear submarines program as follows:

There is strong evidence of an extensive Soviet nuclear

submarine building program. It is estimated that about a half dozen units are now operational, based in the Murmansk area. The combined building rate at Northern and Far Eastern ship-yards is about seven per year. In the future, some nuclear submarines will probably carry missiles to be launched submerged, which we believe could become available in about two years.

both conventional or possibly nuclear powered, I stated to the Subcommittee, "We have recently identified a new class of long-range submarines designated H-class with sails resembling the G-class." I added that this H-class of Soviet submarines was apparently unconventionally propelled, possibly with a nuclear power plant.

carried by both the conventional and the nuclear powered submarines would probably now have a maximum range up to 350 nautical miles and would have to be launched while the submarine was on the surface.

Observations indicate that the H-class submarines which is apparently their first nuclear powered class, are probably somewhat smaller than the 0.3. Polaris Submarines, approximately 250 - 290 feet in length. During our Navy's observations of them their speed

would not make any announcement about their nuclear submarines until they were able to unveil a substantial number of them. This is apparently what they are now preparing to do.
