SOTIFT RUSSIA'S AND RED CHINA'S REACTION TO MIKITA PERUSECULY'S PROCERUL CONTINUES LINE

A leading functionary of the Communist Party, was recently made an extended trip to Red China and the Sputet Union. This individual had lengthy discussions with high-renting officials of the Communist Parties of Red China and the Soviet Union. As a result of these conversations and his personal observations, he made the following comments congerning the reaction of the Soviet Union and Red Oning to Wikita Thrushchey's current peaceful operistence line and the type of reception President Sisenhower could expect during his forthcoming trip to the Soviet Union:

The Russians consider as their main objective the development of what they term the new relationship between the Soviet Union and the United States. This Communist Rarty, BEA, functionary is of the belief that the Soviete in furtherance of their peaceful operistence line may make certain peaceful to the United States in a diplomatic sense but will not make any concessions on matters of communist ideology. The Soutets will however, avoid any actions which would cause a setback in the relationship between the Sovieta and the United States. Fer example, Mikhail Suslov, a member of the Presidius of the Central Cammittee of the Communist Party of the Seviet Union, stated that the Communist Party of the Soviet Union did not send greetings to the Communist Party, USA, on the latter! 40th anniversary in the Pall of 1959 and will not send greating: to the 17th National Convention of the Communist Party, Des. in December, 1959, inasmuch as the Communist Party of the Soviet Union believes that this action might interfere with Soviet - United States relations. As a further example of Soviet thinking along this line, the international compunist publication, "World Warrist Review," has decided against printing an article authored by Villian Z. Poster, the rage emeritus of the Communist Party, USA, in this review in amount as Poster's article makes certain references to President Eisenhower which the Soutets believe mould demage Soviet - United States relations.

This Communist Party, USA, functionary observed that the Soviets are preparing the Bussian people for improved relations and peace with the United States. The Soulets have prepared a special nemercal concerning Wikita Ehrushoneu's visit to the United States and have issued a book dealing with friendship between the United States and the Soutet Paign. The theme in Russia today is for friendship with the United States and the enthusiasm for better relations and peace with the United States was described as being almost like that at a revival meeting. The President of the United States is affectionately referred to as "Ike" and is termed a prest President, and he will receive a tremendous reception in Aussia. It was noted that there are no verbal attacks against Fice President Richard W. Nizon and he is referred to affectionately by the Russian people as *Dick." This Communist Party, USA, functionary further noted that as a result of his trip to the United States and his pendeful openiatenes line that Wikita Ehrushchev is more popular in Russia today than ever before.

Concerning the reaction of Red China to Maryahensuis peaceful coexistence line, this Communist Party, URL, functionary stated that while the peace sentiment is prevalent in Soviet Russia, he received the opposite feeling upon entering Red China. He noted that Khrushshev spoke at a banquet held in Peking, China, in consection with the 10th andiversary celebration of the founding of Red China and that during his speech Thrushchev repeatedly emphasized the need for peace. Thile at the conclusion of this speech, there was applause, is was only polite applause and indicated to this Communist Partil USA, functionary that the Chinese did not support thrushenevis ourrent peaceful coexistence line. The Chinese Communist Perty leaders who also spoke at this anniversary celebration stressed the necessity of defeating United States imperialism and avoided making any reference to Thrushchev's visit to the United States. Photographs of Chinese Communist Party leaders and of Marx, Lanin and Stalin were prominently displayed during the anniversary celebration; however, there was no photograph of Thrushehev on display which indicated to this Pamunist Party, UMA, leader the Chinese displeasure with Ehrushahau's peace hal operistance line.
