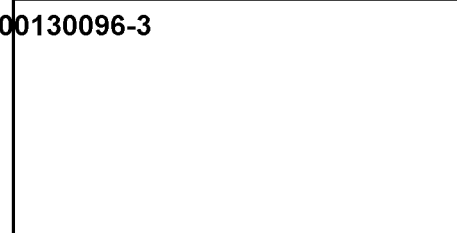

In Mr. Dulles' absence, I am pleased to reply to your letter of 14 September in which you requested his encouragement of Agency employees' participation in United Community Campaigns.

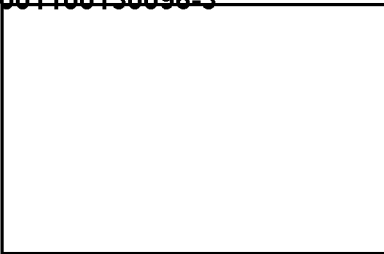

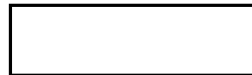
