

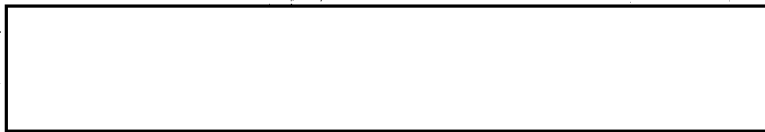

1. I should like to commend [redacted] for the assistance which he has given this Agency since he was first assigned to duty with us in January 1953.

3. This officer has proved particularly capable in handling projects assigned to him with energy and enthusiasm and has also demonstrated great originality and singular initiative in developing new work in these same fields.

4. His extensive Signal Corps background and other technical experience have been most useful to us, and he has continually exhibited superior tact and courtesy in his duties where they involved liaison both with the Army and with the Air Force.

5. Without this officer's able and skillful help, it would not have been possible to carry out this work in a timely and efficient manner. We are indebted not only to [redacted] but also to the Army for assigning him to this Agency and later for continuing him on active duty at our request after he was due for retirement.
