Dear Pearre:

Reference my visit with you in late November, I sincerely appreciate having had the opportunity to visit with you and to discuss possible future connections with the Agency. As I mentioned at that time, I had not made any effort to contact any other possible sources of employment, as before doing so I wanted to get your advice as to the possibility of working in your activity in which, I assure you, I am vitally interested. I appreciate the encouragement which you gave and, after thinking the matter over, I have come to the following conclusions. I am still very much interested in joining the Agency, although I realize that it offers little from a financial viewpoint. However, this is not too important. The above statement is not to be construed as a firm commitment at this time on my part, in case you decide to offer me something. I am starting to make some other contacts to determine what they have to offer. Having decided quite some time ago to serve until mandatory retirement rather than request early voluntary retirement, I feel that I would not want to request voluntary retirement unless something which was really overriding developed.

As I mentioned to you, I definitely want to live in [redacted] or the District of Columbia area. [redacted] says the Washington area is where we are going to locate, so I suppose that will be it. However, I would be willing to live [redacted] for a few years if something developed which required that I do so.

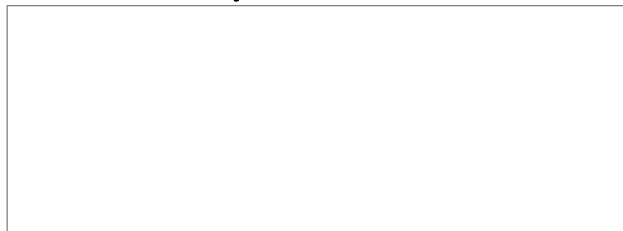
