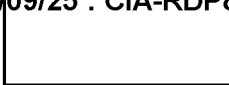

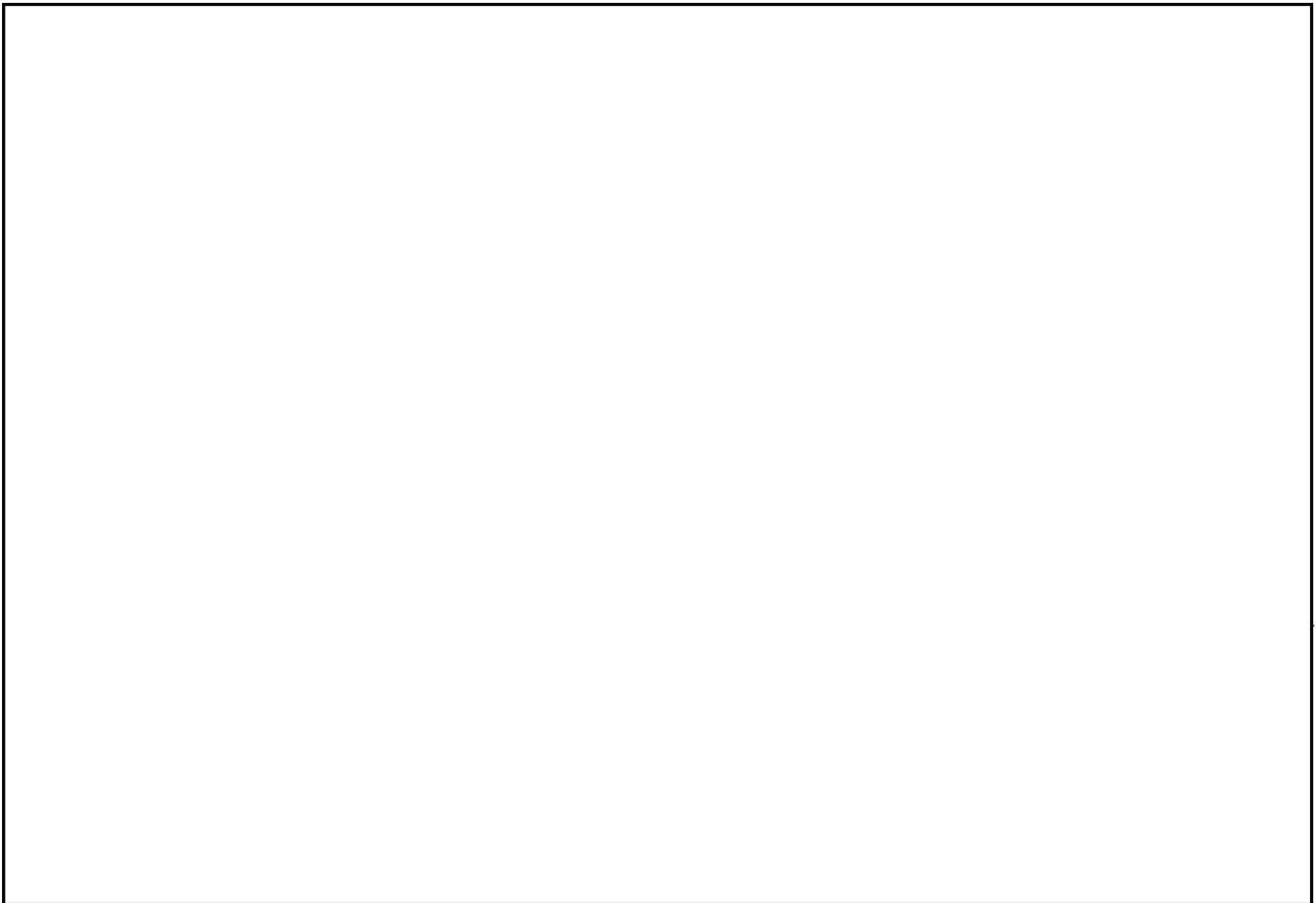
NOTES FOR DDCI

I have checked with Elder who says this is the first he had heard of such a report. He has not received it. Is there anything you want us to do about this?

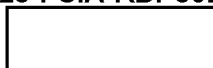

5. Kirk has noted a press report that a panel of heart disease experts have recommended that the country reorganize office work schedules to encourage active exercise to help prevent heart attacks. Kirk has sent this report around to DDS, Tietjen, and others, pointing out that this recommendation "certainly justifies our development of our Exercise Room" and he hopes that more and more Agency employees will use the Room "under carefully controlled and supervised conditions."
