1. Larry Houston reports that the Civil Aeronautics Board has initiated a survey of civil aviation throughout Africa as a basis for determining US civil aviation policy there. It will be a comprehensive study. The Agency will provide intelligence support through ORR and we will obtain the product [redacted]

Bundy has sent a memo dated 11 November to virtually all top officials in the Executive Department citing the intense Presidential interest in Canadian-American relations and complaining that various departments and agencies have, in recent months, been engaged in direct negotiations with opposite numbers in Canada on matters "which have wound up on the President's desk". Bill Brubeck on the White House Staff has been named to handle Canadian affairs and the President wants him kept fully informed on all significant negotiations or plans for negotiations.
