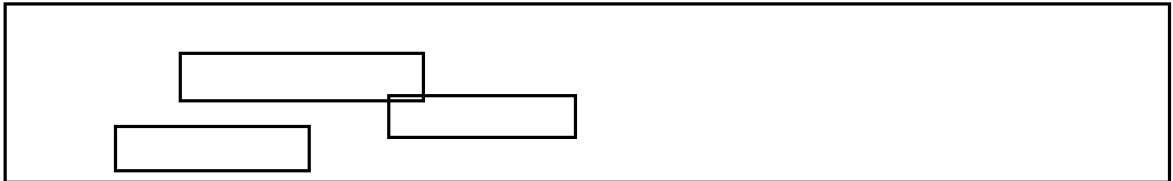

As regards the unfinished business on the matter of DIA briefings given to Goldwater's Capitol Hill Air Force reserve unit and your query as to what further should be done, I asked Kirk for his advice. I have suggested that DD/I might be asked to do a more meaningful assessment of this problem or that it be given to the Bannerman Committee to look into or that the whole matter be put on the USIB Agenda for further discussion. Kirk says he believes this is a political issue and that we should not get caught between DIA and Congress. He believes someone should get a White House view before anything more is done. I will hold onto the papers relating to this in case you want to take it up with the DCI.

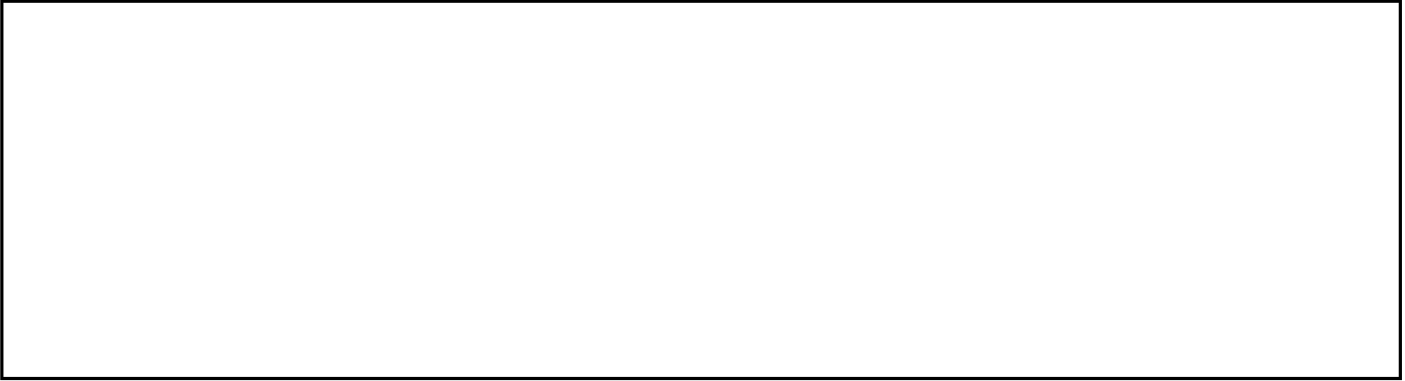

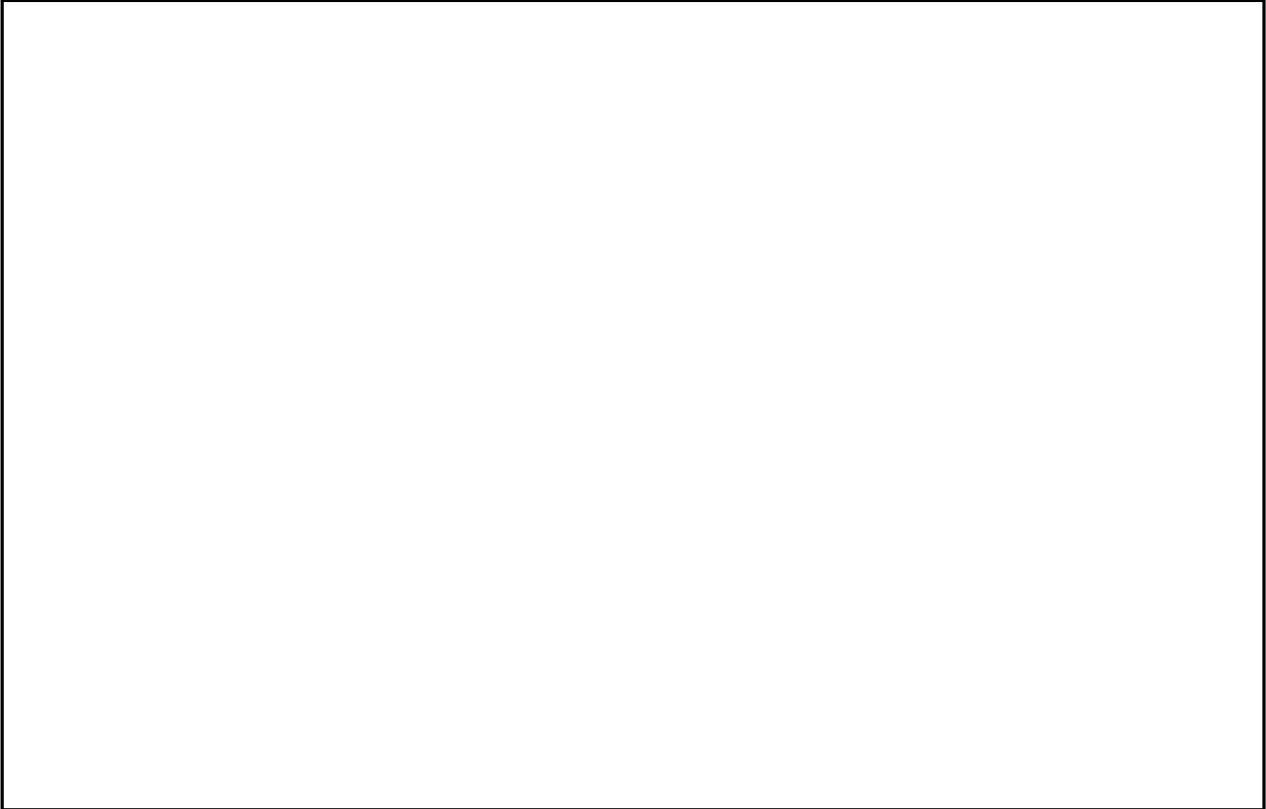
