MEMORANDUM FOR: Deputy Director (Science & Technology)

1. Mr. McCone has in mind presenting the [redacted] problem to the President's Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board as an example of the frustrations and emboglements encountered by CIA in developing and maintaining the type of professional in-house competence the President's Board itself had recommended so strongly two years ago. He therefore needs a narrative-type memorandum (which I think is probably pretty well condensed in the basic memorandum of 1 September) and then a chronology of the problems that have arisen in going ahead with his approved plan [redacted]
