Morning Meeting of 6 June 1966

There was a brief discussion of the status of Senate developments in connection with senatorial oversight of the Agency. It was noted that Senator Russell believes that his position would receive 75 percent approval in the event of a showdown vote on a resolution from the Foreign Relations Committee.

DD/I tabled the latest report from Task Force [redacted] There continues to be no evidence of installation of SSM's in the Vietnam area.

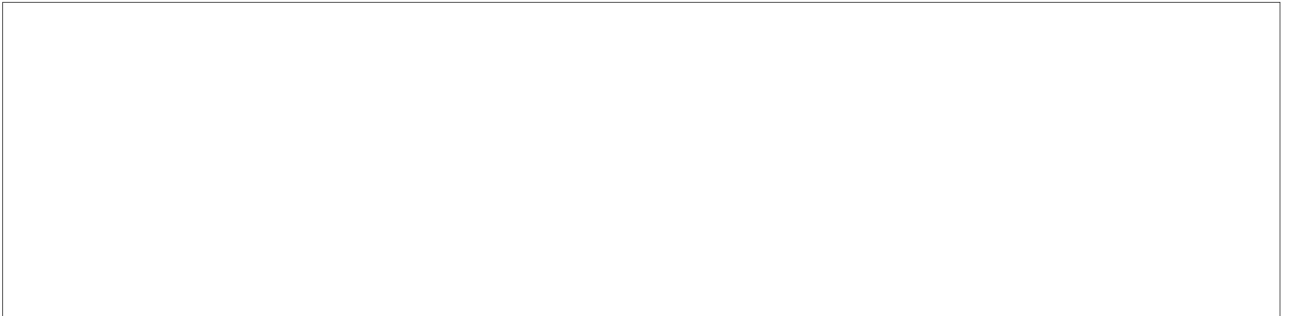
