Godfrey covered developments on Rhodesia and noted a report suggesting that Egypt might be trying to tamp down tensions in the Middle East.

Kent reported that he called Lt. General H. J. Lemley, Jr., on the USSR's strategic attack capability. General Lemley said that he would arrange a briefing. The Director asked Kent to pursue this question.

The Director questioned the necessity for a pre-USIB meeting and indicated that, unless the DD/I notifies him to the contrary, the meeting will not be held.

Carver briefed on actions taken in response to a White House request concerning a Vietnamese personality presently in the U. S.

Carver said that Admiral Lee has asked him to return to the National War College to conduct a seminar. Executive Director asked Carver to inform OTR.

Bross initiated a discussion on noncommunity mapping and charting requirements. He proposes to set up a small CIA/DIA group under General Reynolds to examine this question. DD/I suggested that he and Bross discuss CGS representation.
