MEMORANDUM FOR: Executive Director-Comptroller

SUBJECT : Temporary Delegation of Authority for Short-Term Extensions
Beyond Mandatory Retirement Age for Participants in the
CIA Retirement and Disability System

REFERENCE : Memorandum from Director of Personnel dated 15 June 1965
addressed to the Director of Central Intelligence, subject
as above

1. This memorandum submits a report required in connection with the approval by the Deputy Director of Central Intelligence of the recommendations contained in reference memorandum.

2. Reference memorandum recommended that authority under section 235 (b) of the Central Intelligence Agency Retirement Act of 1964 for Certain Employees be delegated to the Director of Personnel to approve extensions of not more than one year following the date a participant is designated or the date he attains mandatory retirement age, whichever is later. This recommendation was approved by the Deputy Director of Central Intelligence on 29 June 1965 with the proviso that a report be submitted to you monthly citing the names, ranks and lengths of extension. Accordingly, a report covering the extension approved by the Director of Personnel during the month of January 1966 is attached. A total of 19 extensions under this delegation of authority have been approved to date.

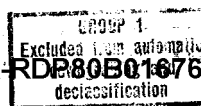
