- b. Guanajay IRBM Site #2. Area appears unchanged however, obliquity and scale preclude detailed interpretation.
- c. <u>Santa Cruz Del Norte Cruise Missile Site</u>. Site contains: One canvas-covered launcher, one uncovered launcher with a possible missile on the launcher, and several canvas-covered vehicles. Status of construction on revetments, previously reported, cannot be determined. Three areas of unidentified activity: Two areas east of the missile site and one area west of the site.

HIGHWAYS

- a. Guanajay Havana. No missile associated convoys; no military concentrations observed on observable portions of the highway.
- b. <u>Havana Area Coastal Highway</u>. No missile associated convoys; no military concentrations on observable portions of the highway.
