Colonel Hansen stated that [redacted] had again written to Trubee Davidson regarding our one-time employment of [redacted]. He noted that the DCI had stated that it was not incumbent on CIA to reply to any [redacted] letters. In this connection Mr. [redacted] stated that Colonel Edwards was interested [redacted] since it was believed that he might have information which would be of use to CIA. Hansen will discuss this matter further with Edwards.

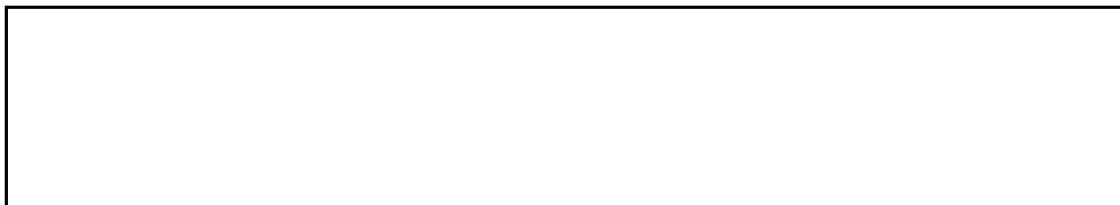

Mr. [redacted] noted that the Fair Employment Board had recently met in the case of a colored employee who had charged discrimination. While the Board determined there was no basis in this case, some interesting statistics were developed as to the number, grades, and assignments of negroes employed by CIA.
