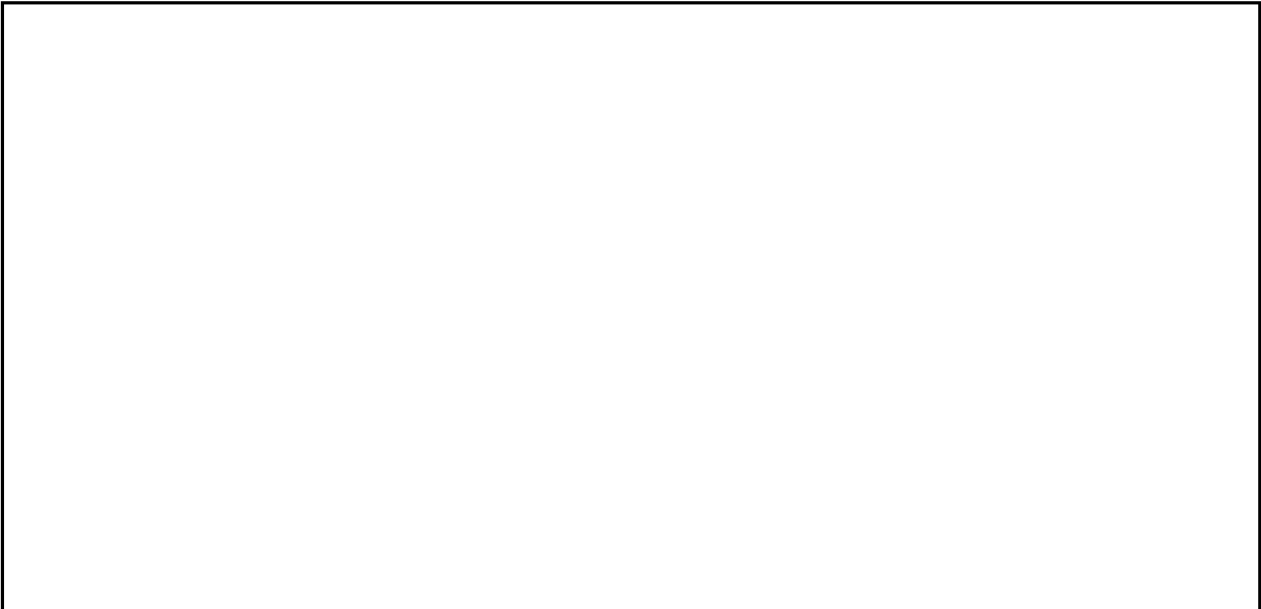

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Mr. Dulles:



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c. Noted a cable from the Senior Representative, [redacted]  
(IN 12703) and approved the suggestion contained therein.

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d. Noted a cable from the Senior Representative, [redacted]  
(IN 12568) respecting the forthcoming visit of [redacted] and  
asked [redacted] to determine whether he (DCI) should do anything  
about this.

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f. Referred to a cable from the Senior Representative,  
[redacted] (IN 12851) respecting [redacted] private  
meeting with [redacted] on 29 May, and asked that the information  
contained in this message "be circulated on the highest level".

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Mr. Dulles (Continued);

g. Asked Mr. Kirkpatrick to look up the debates in Congress (House) at the time the National Security Act of 1947 was being considered, and in particular that portion referring to CIA and the responsibility for production of Estimates.

h. Referred to a proposed letter for his signature to the Secretary of State, respecting an agreement between the U.S. and selected foreign countries for the establishment of radio stations, and asked General Cabell to further discuss this matter with [redacted]. The Director said he was concerned over FBI reaction to this proposal and asked that consideration be given to touching base with that Agency.
