Mr. Dulles:

a. Noted a letter from General Trudeau containing G-2 complaints of the slowness in receiving information obtained from [redacted] and stated that the reply to this communication should be completely documented and handled as a matter of priority.

General Cabell:

Noted that [redacted] the new AD for Personnel, was in Washington this week on temporary duty and would actually take over effective 18 January. General Cabell urged that those present advise their people not to make too many personal requests to [redacted] until he has an opportunity to become oriented.

Mr. Amory:

a. Suggested that [redacted] be invited to attend an IAC Meeting during his forthcoming visit to Washington. The Director approved provided: (1) that this was cleared with the other members of the IAC; (2) the Agenda of the Meeting which he attends will contain only items which might be appropriately discussed.

b. Referred to a cable from the Senior Representative, [redacted] (IN 46691) and suggested that the Director might wish to discuss its contents at today's OCB Meeting and, in particular, if the events referred to therein happen, their impact on the Berlin Conference. The Director approved.

Colonel White:

a. Referred to the new regulations on the domestic use of Agency automobiles and after some discussion the Director approved these regulations. In this connection, the DCI directed that: (1) his car and the Deputy Director's car be assigned to the Office of the Director; (2) free utilization should be made of these cars when not required by himself or General Cabell.
