Referred to the proposed paper on Agreed Activities, and stated we should ensure that the language contained therein provided for the coordination of operations now being conducted by the Military services. In connection with this paper, General Cabell said that as a result of [redacted] meeting yesterday with the Service representatives, it had "been agreed to disagree" and these representatives felt they could go no further with the current proposal on this subject. After some discussion the Director indicated he would meet with the Service Intelligence Chiefs and Mr. Armstrong after the IAC Meeting today and advise them of his intention of placing this problem before the NSC after he had the opportunity to inform Deputy Secretary of Defense Anderson of the action he proposed to take.

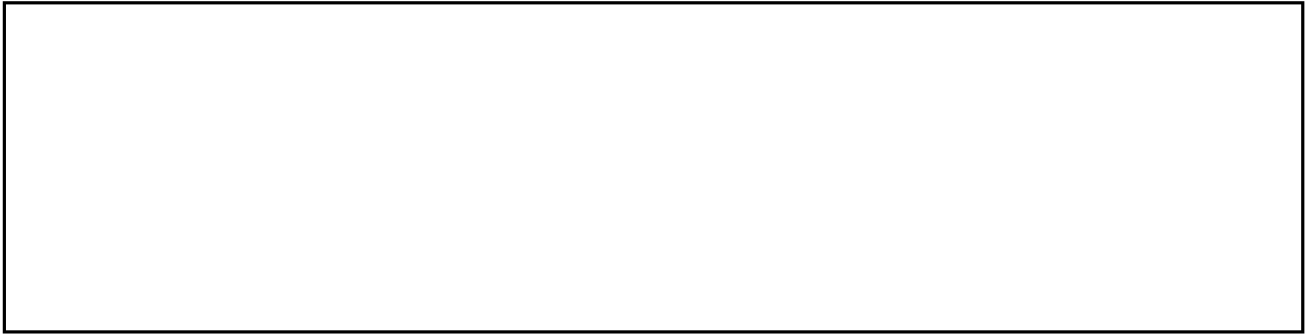
