# Dalai Lama's Brother on Way To Enroll As U. C. Student

The 20 year old brother of Tibet's Dalai Lama left London by air last night on a trip to the United States and Berkeley, where he will become an undergraduate at the University of California.

Jensten Dhondrup, whose brother was the spiritual and temporal ruler of Tibet until the country was invaded by Chinese Communists, arrived in London early yesterday morning from New Delhi, the Associated Press reported.

He and his companion, neither of whom can speak any European language, spent the day sightseeing in London with the aid of a guidebook written 42 years ago by an Indian Baptist missionary.

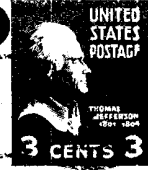
Dispatches said the pair answered customs and immigration

questions with quaint and inappropriate guidebook phrases such as "There are a great many landlords under the British" and "That is the gunfire of one o'clock."

Nevertheless, they managed to get aboard a Pan American Airways plane for the United States. They still had the guidebook.
