
MEMORANDUM FOR THE FILES:

25X1 In saying goodbye to Chris Herter today before his
25X1 departure for the Geneva Conference, I took up one or two matters
of business, including our intention to [redacted]

25X1 Mr. Herter raised no objection whatever to proceeding,
