We have reviewed Mr. [redacted] file and find that he was not offered employment because his qualifications, in the broadest sense of this term, did not meet our overall standards of employment. In advising Mr. [redacted] of this decision, we explained that this conclusion was based on an evaluation of his entire record and that no single factor was determining.
