MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Central Intelligence

SUBJECT : Meeting of the President's Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board, Monday and Tuesday, October 16 and 17, 1961

1. Mr. Coyne has advised me that the President's Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board will meet on Monday and Tuesday, October 16 and 17, and Dr. Killian has requested that plans be made for the Board to visit the new Agency building and also for the Board to visit the National Indications Center.

2. Subject to your concurrence, the suggested schedule for the Board would be on Monday afternoon, October 16, at 2 p.m. leave the White House for the new building; 2:20 arrive at the new building; 2:20 -- 2:40 p.m. visit the key spots in the new building such as the auditorium, cafeteria, OCI and OCR; 2:40 p.m. meeting with the DCI in the ONE Conference Room; 3:40 p.m. leave CIA Building for Pentagon; 4 p.m. -- meeting in NIC Center of Pentagon for briefing on Watch Committee and NIC Operations.
