1. [Redacted] said they would like to run a story one week from today on the Russian-Red Chinese coolness. They would like to know the answers to what is eating them. Are they divided, or is it a game?
2. [Redacted] people noted at the Agricultural Meeting recently in Moscow, the Chinese Communists, if present at all, were certainly not in the foreground. Why is this, [Redacted] asks?
3. If there are any differences that could be widened by a story in [Redacted] and if we can furnish data to support such a belief that there are differences, [Redacted] would like to discuss it with some informed representative of the Agency, not later than Thursday, 11 February 1960.
4. Does PP/NSP wish to tackle this, or does the DDI have anything to contribute?
