SUBJECT: Request for Approval of Prospective Consultant

1. Problem

To secure approval to approach [redacted] for the purpose of exploring the possibility of securing his services as a consultant on the ORR Aircraft Panel.

2. Discussion

With the increasing emphasis being placed by ORR upon USSR jet production, it has been felt for some time that an expert in the production methods and inputs required for jet engine production should be added to the ORR Aircraft Panel. Accordingly, [redacted] Chief of the Aircraft Branch, Industrial Division, ORR, was authorized to approach [redacted]

[redacted] to discuss the problem of obtaining a consultant from that firm. It was suggested by [redacted]

[redacted] was the most qualified man at the [redacted] for our purpose. During these discussions it was made clear to [redacted] that further action on the subject would require further formal approval by the Agency.

[redacted] services can be obtained as a continuing consultant to ORR, it is anticipated that he will be used two days each month in Fiscal Year 1954. I&S indices checks have been made and approved.

3. Recommendation

That ORR be authorized to contact [redacted] and to take the necessary personnel action if indicated. Rate of compensation: \$50.00 per day.
