2. Prior to the expiration of this contract 30 June 1954, a request for the extension of the contract was submitted, and later returned, pending further action by the Security Division. In referenced memoranda by the Chief, Security Division, security clearance was granted to permit an extension through 31 October 1954, and subsequently extended to 30 November 1954. During this interim the services of [redacted] were utilized in October and November by the Office of National Estimates.
