SUBJECT : Approval of Prospective Consultant

1. Problem: To obtain approval of the employment of Dr. [redacted] as an intermittent consultant.

2. Facts Bearing on the Problem:

a. [redacted] has been a member of the Board of National Estimates since January 1952 and is resigning on 6 August 1954 to enter non-governmental employment.
