- 1. In a recent memorandum to the Civil Service Commission Chairman, President Carter stated his Administration's policy regarding participation in meetings or conferences held in facilities in which discrimination is practiced.

The attached amendment to FPM chapter 410 informs agencies of the Presidential policy that Federal personnel acting in their official capacities shall not participate in any conferences or meetings held in facilities in which discrimination is practiced on the basis of sex, religion, or national origin, as well as race.

The policy announced in section 8-4 of this chapter was amended by the President on June 2, 1977. In a memorandum to the Commission, the President expressed his Administration's policy that Federal personnel acting in their official capacities shall not participate in any conferences or meetings hold in facilities in which discrimination is practiced on the basis of sex, religion, or national origin, as well as race.
