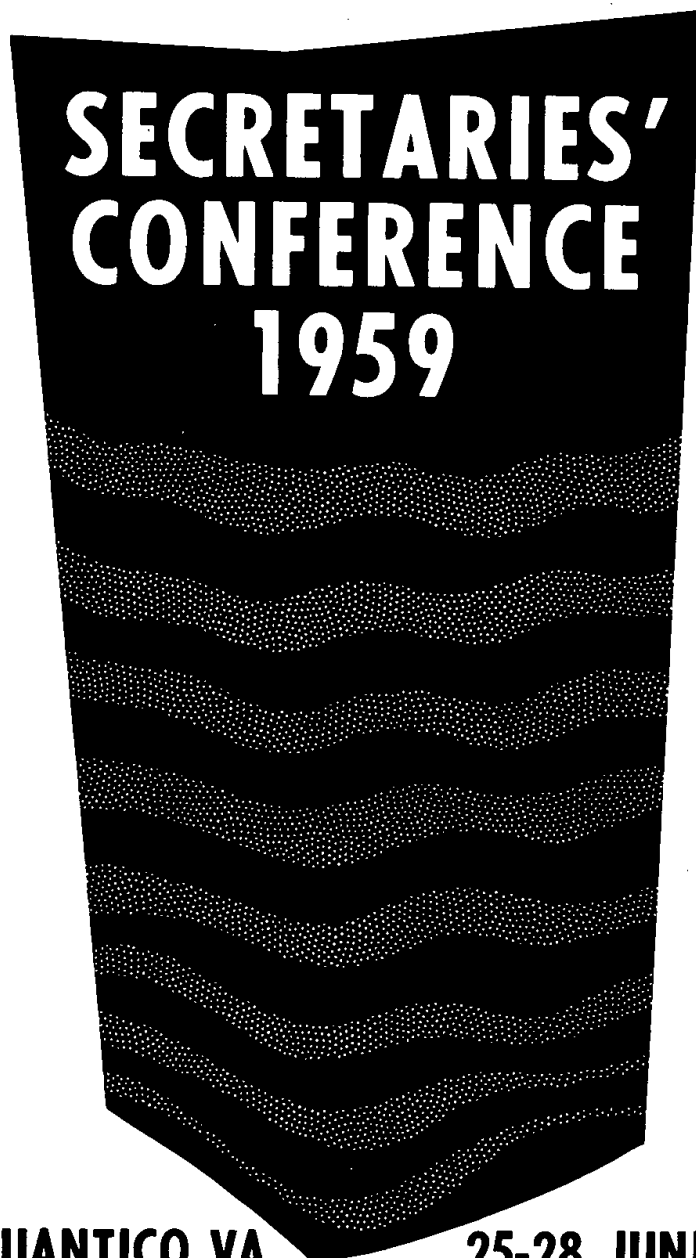


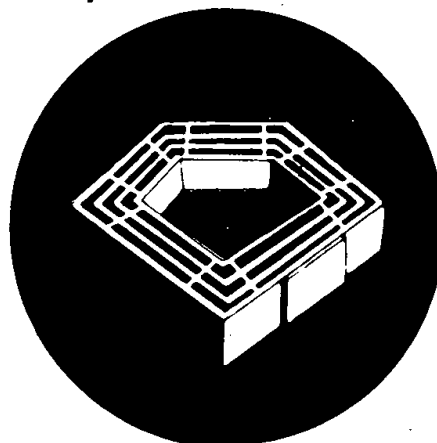

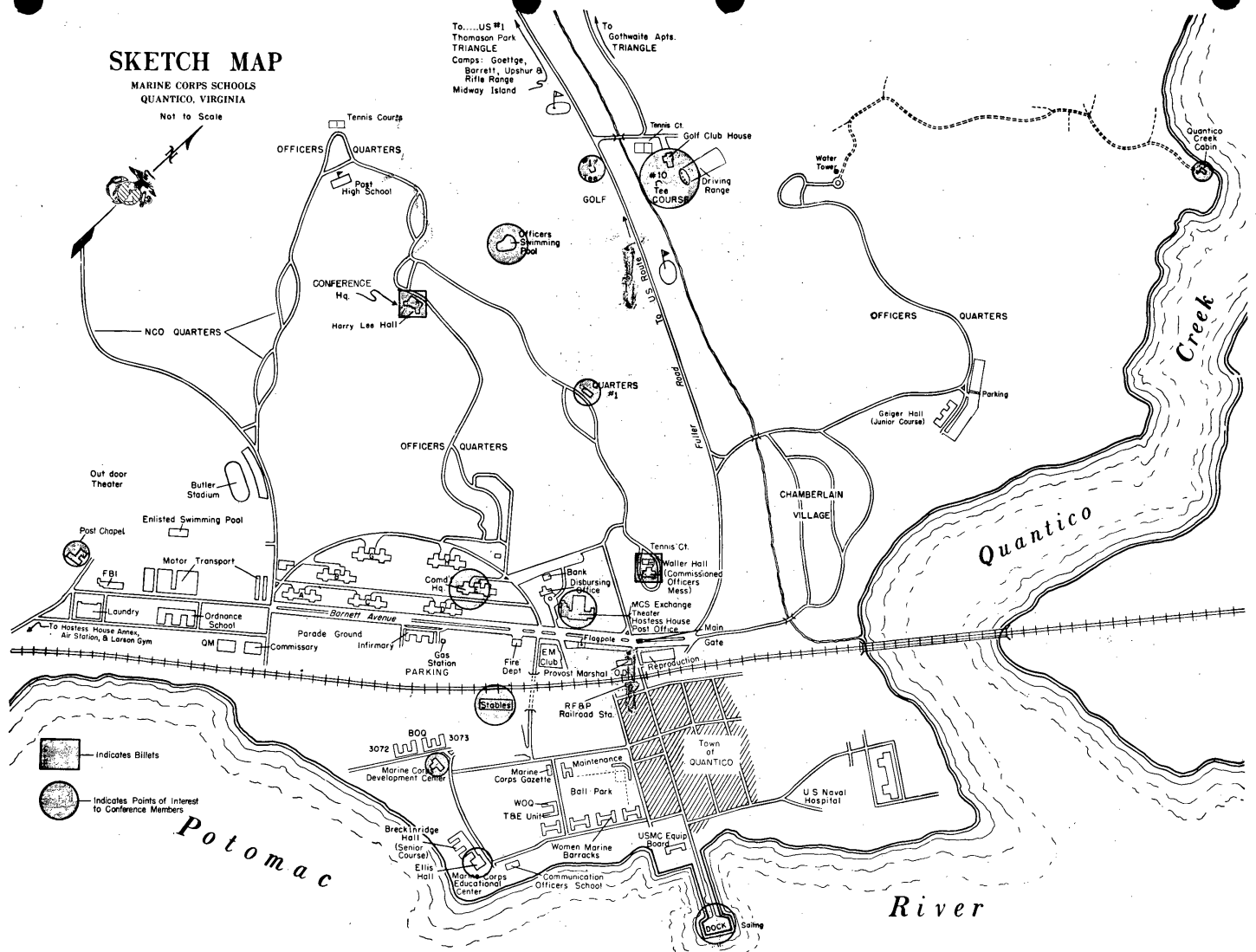
SKETCH MAP
