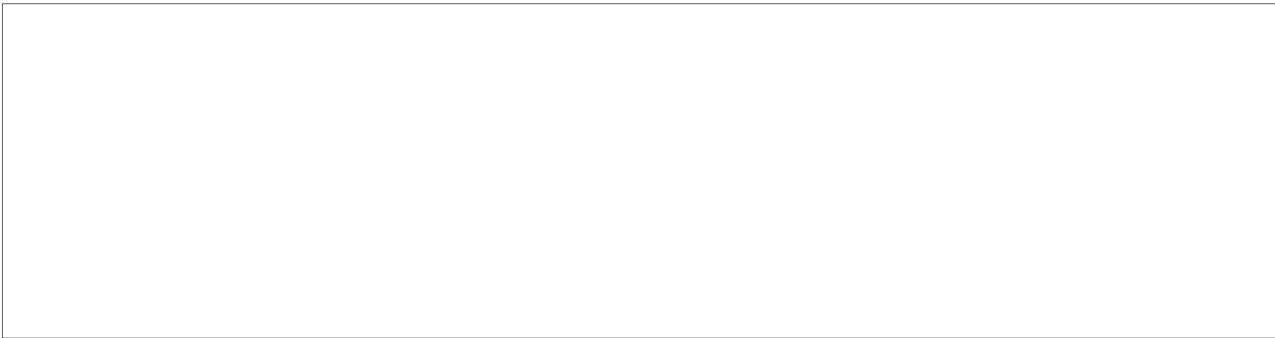
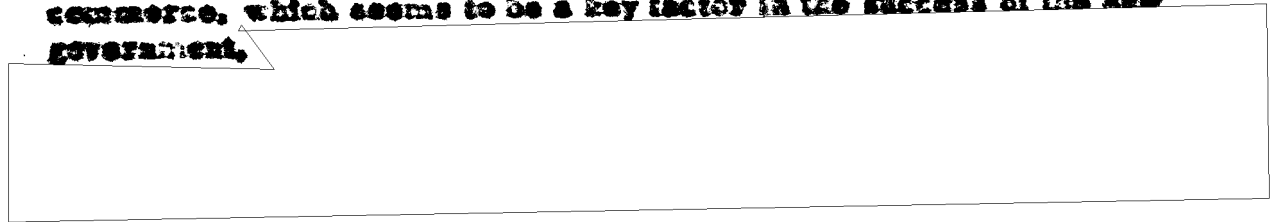

The following is a follow-up Action Memorandum on the meeting with the DCI on Friday, 4 January 1963. All action should be considered that of the DD/P unless otherwise indicated. Any reports or recommendations for the DCI and DDGI should be routed through this office.

1. Dominican Republic. Following the discussion of the situation in that country, the DCI indicated that he thought the Agency should keep an eye on the management of Dominican industry and commerce, which seems to be a key factor in the success of the new government.
