Dear Mr. Marcy:

The Chairman, Intelligence Research and Development Council, and the Council members concurred in the observations, conclusions, and recommendations on remote sensor technology presented by your office at the 4 February meeting.

As follow-on action, the Chairman requests that you convene an ad hoc working group on remote sensor technology composed of CIA, ARPA, and U.S. Navy representatives. The working group should accomplish the following:

Develop a terms of reference by 4 April 1975 for a permanent subcommittee of the IR&D Council on remote sensor technology. The terms of reference should address:

1. Exchange of technology and associated R&D planning,
2. formulation of an R&D strategy for remote sensor technology,
3. interface with operational intelligence planners and requirements, and
4. semi-annual formal reporting to the IR&D Council.
