PRAVDA ON ATOMIC POOL PROPOSAL

- I. Pravda article (29 May) on Eisenhower atomic pool proposal is:
 - A. First public rejection President's proposal;
 - B. Parallel to earlier Soviet aide-memoire (27 April).

 - A. Provides only small quantity atomic material under international control.
 - B. Is "new step on path of further intensifying atomic weapon race."
