MENDES-FRANCE'S INDOCHINA POLICY

- I. French Premier firm on achieving "satisfactory cease-fire" by 20 July.
 - A. Obtained Assembly majority largely due promise to resign if fails.
 - B. Knows his main interest--economic reform--depends on settlement:
 - 1. Program impossible while war drain continues.
 - Needs prestige of settlement to put program through.
- II. Plans for negotiations:
 - A. He will conduct them personally:
 - Met Chou at Bern yesterday as first step.
 - B. Hopes current nine-power discussions
 will lead to agreement permitting
 foreign ministers return Geneva
 by 12 July.
