C. When final exchange details were worked out with other side, these should be reviewed with General Quang and Colonel Binh who would brief President Thieu on the arrangement. At that time Thieu would give his final blessing to the exchange.

2. In terms of atmospherics it worth noting that Thieu did not like idea of exchanging for others who unknown in terms of numbers, names or nationalities. He finally agreed to para 1 scenario, however, out of sympathy in humanitarian and political terms for dilemma which POW issue poses to United States Government.
