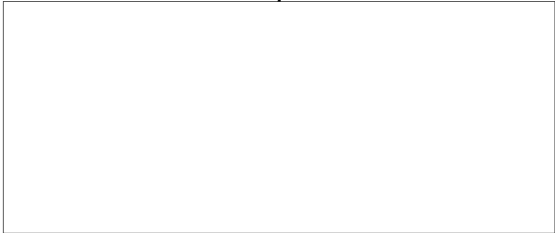



1. This memorandum is for information only.


2. Judge Alexander Holtzoff of the District Court for the District of Columbia today granted the Government's motion for summary judgment in the case of  for reinstatement in the Central Intelligence Agency. This ruling successfully disposes of the case in the District Court.

3. Judge Holtzoff based this ruling on the exercise by the Director of the plenary power contained in section 102(c) of the National Security Act of 1947, as amended, and in so doing remarked that although he was not required to give any reason for his action, the Director had in fact done so in this case.

4.  after the ruling was handed down, told Francis L. Young, Jr., the Assistant United States Attorney who argued the case for the Government, that he intended to appeal the ruling.
