In order that the Control Intelligence Agency ma effectively carry out its responsibilities for coordination in the field of foreign economic intelligence, as recently defined by the Matienal Security Council in MEGID 15, there has been established an Aconomic Intelligence Committee with Dr. Naz F. Willikan, Assistant Director for Research and Reports of this Agency, as Chairman. The terms of reference for this Committee were approved by the Intelligence Advisory Committee on 17 May 1951.

It is therefore requested that you needente two persons to represent your Agency on this Conmittee at the earliest practicable date. These nominees should be individuals most familiar with your total economic research affort. Although your representatives will not be asked to mit at every meeting of this Consittee there will be many occasions when it would be useful to have your Agency participate in Countities deliberations. Initially, the matter of highest priority for committee consideration is the economy of the Soviet orbit, and at least one representative should be familiar with your compute research program as it relates to this geographic area. For administrative purposes one of those nominees should be designated as the
