1. Governmental agency comments in response to the Central Intelligence Agency draft of Foreign Economic Intelligence Requirements Relating to the National Security remain partly incomplete, requiring further investigation.

2. A partial response to the survey of facilities and arrangements from the Department of State has been rescheduled for 1 March 1951. All other responses have been received.

3. The Central Intelligence Agency is analyzing all of this data to present the plan required by NSC Action 282. Tentative deadline for the completion of analysis is still set for 31 March 1951.
