- 1. Governmental agency comments in response to the Central Intelligence Agency draft of Foreign Economic Intelligence Requirements Relating to the National Security remain partly incomplete, requiring further investigation.
- 2. A partial response to the survey of facilities and arrangements from the Department of State has been rescheduled for 1 March 1951. All other responses have been received.
- 3. The Central Intelligence Agency is analyzing all of this data to present the plan required by NSC Action 282. Tentative dead-line for the completion of analysis is still set for 31 March 1951.
