Military Assistance for Emergency Needs

REFERENCE:

NSC 18/4

Pursuant to paragraph 28 of NSC 18/4, approved by the President on November 18, 1949, the National Security Council is having a study prepared of the methods by which the United States can make available military assistance to meet emergency needs not provided for in existing legislation.

In this connection it is requested that an estimate be prepared of those likely contingencies where military assistance may be requested which is not provided for in existing legislation, together with an analysis of any problems in connection therewith peculiar to particular foreign countries or areas.
