## EXCERPT FROM REFERENCES B

- 4. b. Staff responsibilities of the Director of Training for technical supervision of all training not conducted by him, and for which he should now have authority and responsibility to exercise, may be defined to include:
  - (1) Staff coordination with, and technical assistance to all components of the Agency in the preliminary stages of the planning and development of new training projects. This includes:
    - (a) the development of the training objective for the project:
    - (b) planning and developing the various courses of instruction re wired to meet the training doctrine, course centent, duration of courses, lesson plans, methods of instruction, and training materials and aids to be employed;
    - (c) provision for the testing, evaluation, and assessment of the aptitudes of those selected to require and apply the instruction, and the testing and evaluation of the results of the instruction given;
    - (d) establishment of criteria governing the selection of training sites and organizational structure for the training activity.
  - (2) Staff review and approval of all new training projects, and technical review of all existing training projects, in accordance with the criteria stated in paragraph b. (1) above.
  - (3) Establishment of criteria governing the selection of personnel for duty assignments as instructors.
  - (4) Final review and approval of the qualifications of personnel nominated for assignment to training projects as instructors.
